Press Liaison volunteer	To support our ongoing programme of media activity, based on consistent, strong, key messages, across local, regional and national press by developing relationships with local media partners
Events volunteer	Needed on an Ad Hoc basis to help at various events. This role is varied, fun and you get the opportunity to meet lots of people. You can be involved in helping to set up equipment etc for the event, serving refreshments, stewarding, checking tickets, helping on stalls, and helping to clear up including litter picking. We need people who are confident, willing to be flexible and, like to get "stuck in". Events are held at various times including weekends, so this role is great for people who are not able to commit on a weekly basis.
History Tour Guide	This role is ideal for someone who is passionate about history especially that of Sheffield General Cemetery and can talk confidently in front of people about this history. Full support via a history mentor is given. History tours run every first Sunday in each month and occasionally in the week (Private tours for groups) Volunteers normally do 4 or 5 tours per year.
Events - Children's activities	To help at various events throughout the year with children's art and craft activities. To demonstrate the activities to children and encourage them to get involved.
